

UNEMPLOYMENT DUES

Members who receive a layoff notice, and who wish to maintain their membership in good standing with Local Lodge 764, must remit Unemployment Dues directly to the Local Lodge within sixty (60) days of receipt of their last payroll cheque from the company.

Unemployment Dues are two dollars (\$2.00) per month, and the member can pay by cheque either monthly, quarterly (\$8.00) or annually (\$24.00), with the cheque made payable to Local Lodge 764, IAMAW at the address above. Unemployment Dues are tax deductible, and a receipt for dues received will be issued to the member at year end. If the member is recalled, any unemployment dues paid in advance will be refunded to the member without delay.

The payment of unemployment dues ensures that the member does not have a break in IAM longevity for Pin service award purposes. In addition, the member has access to all bulletins, remains in "good standing" at Union Meetings and is eligible to participate in Lodge activities, and can receive timely information as the industry changes and recalls are actioned. Please ensure that you keep the Local Lodge updated if you move or change your telephone number while on layoff.

The IAM Constitution Article G makes it the member's responsibility to remit unemployment dues in a timely fashion to the Local Lodge.
