RESPONSE LETTERS TO THE CIRB

RE: AIR CANADA / AVEOS SPLIT

As you will have noticed by now, Air Canada has posted notices in the workplace informing you of their application to the *Canadian Industrial Relations Board*. The application is asking the *CIRB* to split the Certification and Bargaining unit of the IAM & AW currently working for Air Canada. This will result in a large number of our members no longer being employees of Air Canada.

The *Canada Labour Code* requires the posting of this notice in the workplace. Besides merely informing you of the company's filing with the *Board*, it also serves as notice of the time period that is available to each and every IAM & AW member to file a response with the *Board* about this application.

I would encourage every member who has a concern about the pending split of the Bargaining Unit to send a response letter to the *CIRB* **prior to the July 15th, 2010 deadline**. Your response can be **faxed to 1 – 416 – 973 – 6543**.

You can either write a personal and detailed response as to why you do not support the application or you can visit the Local Lodge 764 website at www.iam764.ca and view 2 sample letters that are posted there. You can download either of these sample letters and amend them as you wish, add your name and fax them to the *CIRB*. **The *CIRB* file number is 28234-C**

Please take the time to submit a response and let the *Board* know that you oppose the application as it is presently structured. Thank you.
